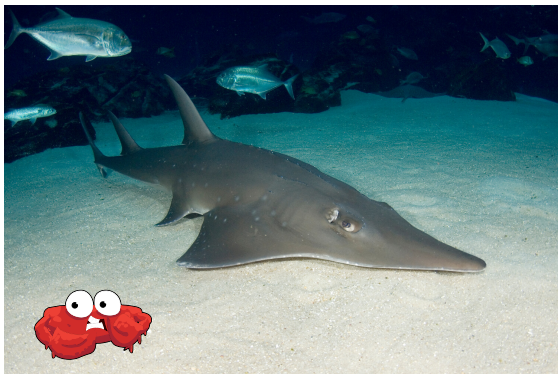


# WHITE-SPOTTED WEDGEFISH

*(Rhynchobatus australiae)*

- Despite their shark-like appearance, they are actually rays.
- Can reach 3 meters in length ( 10 ft).
- Found in the Indian Ocean and the western Pacific Ocean.



- Diet is mainly crabs, shrimp, clams and bottom-dwelling fish.
- Listed as Critically Endangered on the IUCN Red List.
