


SHARKS WHITE-SPOTTED WEDGEFISH

(Rhynchobatus australiae)

- Despite their shark-like appearance, they are actually rays.
- Can reach 3 meters in length (10 ft).
- 🛩 Found in the Indian Ocean and the western Pacific Ocean.





Diet is mainly crabs, shrimp, clams and bottomdwelling fish.

Listed at Critically Endangered on the IUCN Red List.
