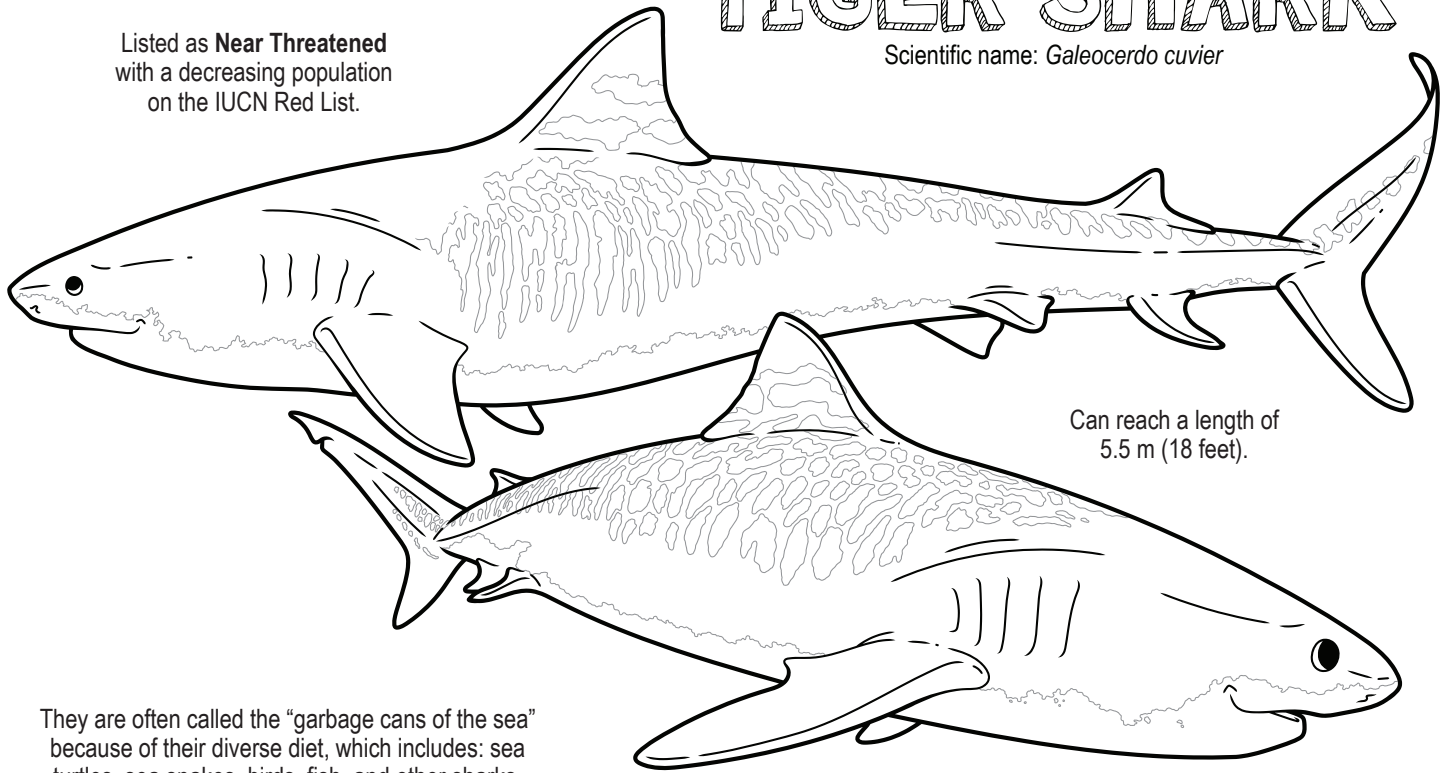


TIGER SHARK

Scientific name: *Galeocerdo cuvier*

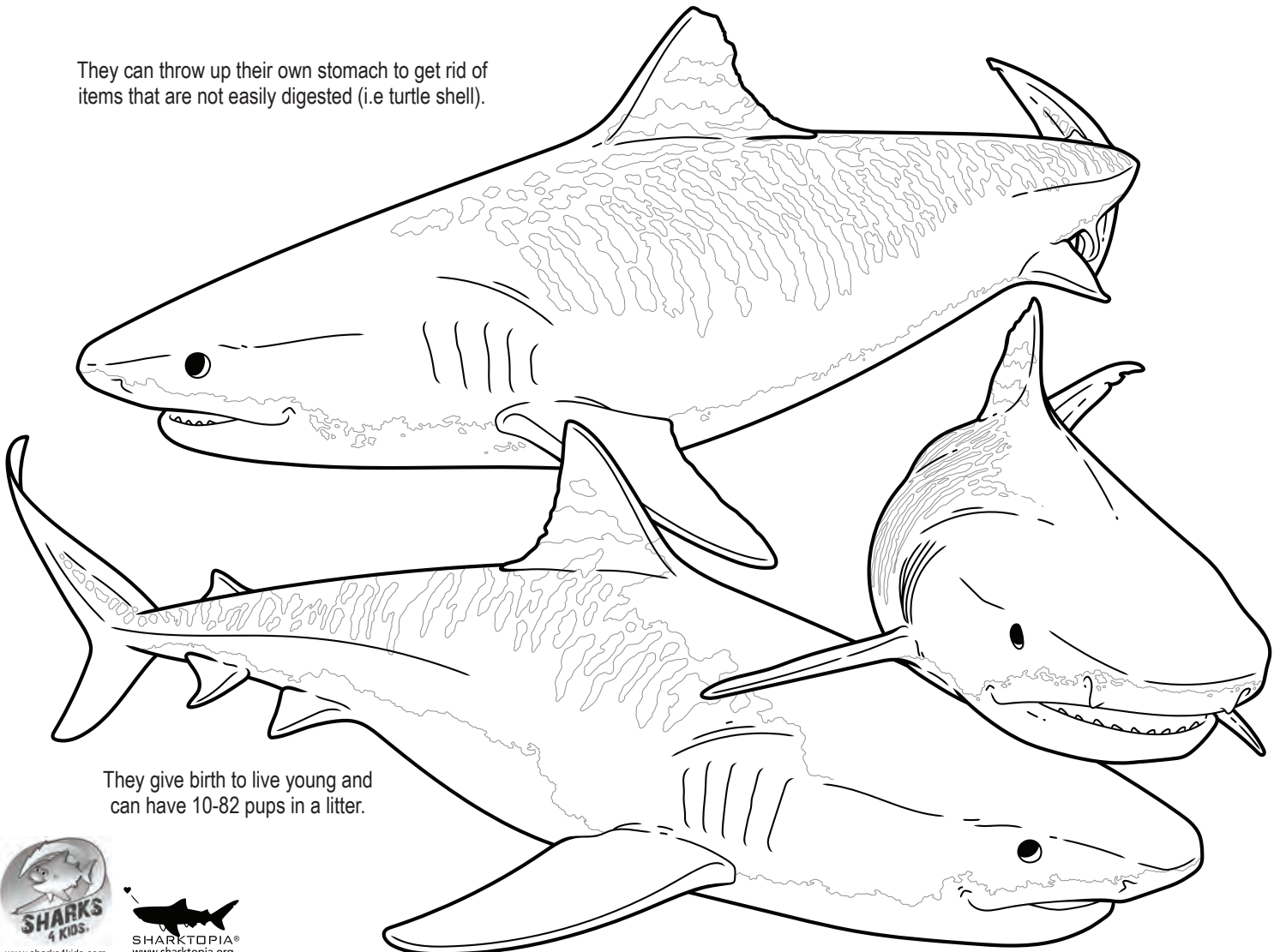
Listed as **Near Threatened**
with a decreasing population
on the IUCN Red List.



Can reach a length of
5.5 m (18 feet).

They are often called the “garbage cans of the sea”
because of their diverse diet, which includes: sea
turtles, sea snakes, birds, fish, and other sharks.

They can throw up their own stomach to get rid of
items that are not easily digested (i.e turtle shell).



They give birth to live young and
can have 10-82 pups in a litter.
