

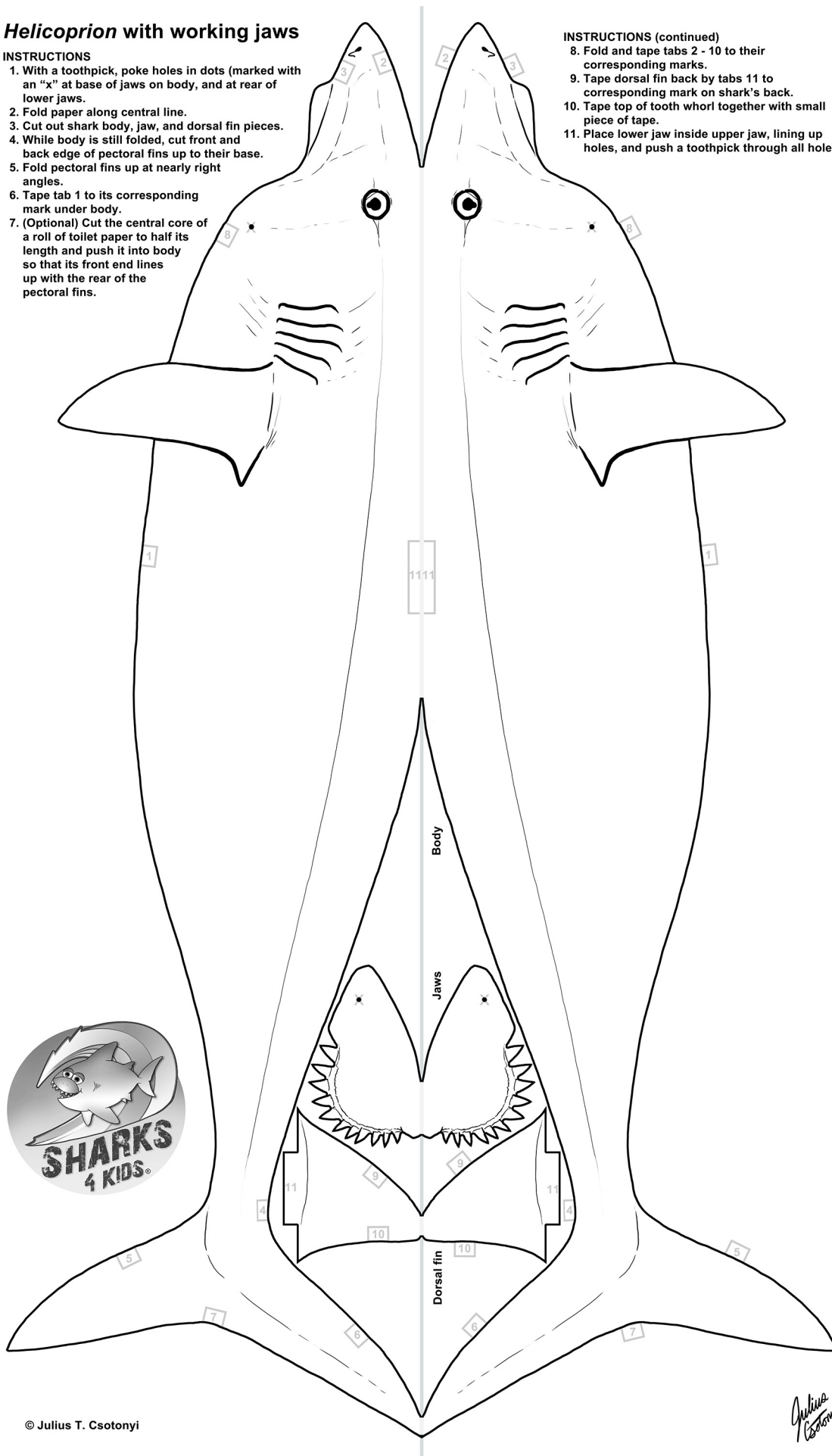
Helicoprion with working jaws

INSTRUCTIONS

1. With a toothpick, poke holes in dots (marked with an "x" at base of jaws on body, and at rear of lower jaws.
2. Fold paper along central line.
3. Cut out shark body, jaw, and dorsal fin pieces.
4. While body is still folded, cut front and back edge of pectoral fins up to their base.
5. Fold pectoral fins up at nearly right angles.
6. Tape tab 1 to its corresponding mark under body.
7. (Optional) Cut the central core of a roll of toilet paper to half its length and push it into body so that its front end lines up with the rear of the pectoral fins.

INSTRUCTIONS (continued)

8. Fold and tape tabs 2 - 10 to their corresponding marks.
9. Tape dorsal fin back by tabs 11 to corresponding mark on shark's back.
10. Tape top of tooth whorl together with small piece of tape.
11. Place lower jaw inside upper jaw, lining up holes, and push a toothpick through all holes.
