

Clothespin Sharks

<u>Materials:</u>

- Clothespins (with springs)
- Paintbrushes
- Paint (Grey, white, etc.)
- Glue
- Googly Eyes
- Scissors
- Foam (Grey, white, etc.)
- Black pen or fine-tipped permanent marker



Craft Instructions:

- 1) Paint your clothespins grey, or if making a specific type of shark, change the color! (Examples: Yellow for lemon shark or blue for blue shark). Set the clothespins aside on a paper plate and allow them to dry. This might take 15 minutes or longer.
- 2) While waiting for paint to dry, use stencils to cut fins out of the grey foam. Make 2 dorsal fins, a caudal fin, and 2 pectoral fins. If making the shark body a color other than grey, you'll have to paint the fins to match.
- 3) Cut a few small triangles out of the white foam to create shark teeth. (These will need to be really tiny, so be careful!)
- 4) Once the grey paint has dried, paint the underside of the clothespin white. Set the clothespins down, bottom side up, and allow them to dry again.
- 5) Once the clothespins are fully dried, glue a googly eye on each side of the clothespin on the front end near the opening.
- 6) Next, carefully glue the 5 fins onto the appropriate spots. Be extra careful with the pectoral fins because they might be near the springs, depending on your specific clothespin.
- 7) Next, glue the teeth on the top and bottom of the opening of the clothespin.

8) Finally, draw 5 gill slits on either side of the head, just behind the googly eyes and above the pectoral fins.




Thresher Shark







This project is a great way to learn the different anatomy of different shark species!












Cephalofoil

2nd Dorsal Fin




Caudal Fin

Great Hammerhead




Whale Shark


